PART C: PERIOD OF CONTRACT

The contract period shall be from January 1, 2022 or date of award if later, through December 31, 2022. Should the contractor dispose of their business during the contract period, all obligations shall pass to the new owner(s), who shall be required to submit a proposal in accordance with the requirements of the contract.

This contract shall not bind, nor purpose to bind, the Park System for any contractual commitment in excess of the original contract period. The Park System shall have the right, at its sole option, to extend the contract for two (2) additional 1-year periods (2023-2024). In the event the Park System exercises such right, all terms, conditions, and provisions of the contract shall remain the same and apply during the renewal period.

This is an open-end contract. The goods and/or services are on-call if and when needed. The quantities and dollar amounts bid are estimates and the Board of Recreation Commissioners reserve the right to increase quantities using unit prices or total dollar amount by up to 20% or decrease quantities or total dollar amount by up to 100%.
